

ICE FLYERS FAN CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct is established to set the guidelines for acceptable behavior for members of the Ice Flyers Fan Club. The code is designed to protect the integrity of the Fan Club while working with and assisting the Ice Flyers staff and players. All members are to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positive representation upon the organization, players, Fan Club and individual. The Ice Flyers will review any and all reports of violations of the following listed rules. If a warning is issued and goes unheeded, termination of the offender's membership with no refund will result.

1. Club members will at all times abide by and follow all SPHL rules and regulations pertaining to Fan Clubs. Any participation and/or contribution to acts that would be deemed salary cap violations as outlined by the SPHL will not be tolerated and will lead to immediate termination of your Fan Club membership and the cancellation of your season tickets. The SPHL has strict penalties affecting the ownership, coach and players should salary cap violations occur. Therefore, the Ice Flyers must also take a strict stance on these violations.
2. Conduct yourself with decorum and politeness at all Club and Ice Flyers functions. This includes home and away games, treatment towards opposing teams' fans, players, coaches, staff or league officials, both on and off the ice. All members shall hold themselves responsible for sportsmanlike conduct at all times.
3. Follow the rules and regulation of the arenas in which we play.
4. The excessive use of alcohol in any form at any hockey related and Fan Club activity is discouraged.
5. Harassing and/or stalking of the Ice Flyers hockey players, their families or any visiting teams' players will not be tolerated. This includes stalking as defined by state statute, phone calls, emails, text messages, letters, pictures, faxes, social media sites, or other internet abuse.
6. There shall be no unwarranted or unwelcome contact between players or other Club members. Unwarranted contact shall include, but not limited to, inappropriate contact with players, players' families or significant others.
7. If a Club member establishes a relationship, whether casual or acknowledged, with a player, the Ice Flyers organization must be notified.
8. There shall be no unauthorized possession, distribution or use of private phone, mobile phone numbers, home addresses, private email addresses or personal possessions of any of the Ice Flyers players or staff members. No Club member shall put a player in a position whereby he feels forced and/or obligated to give out any personal information including cell phone numbers and email addresses.
9. Club members are at times privy to personal information about players and staff or other information given by the front office. These are confidential matters and should not be discussed with anyone not directly involved. Failure to keep this information confidential can result in termination of membership. Any member seen conducting themselves at any Club function in a manner which could have a derogatory affect against any portion of the Code of Conduct or against the reputation of the Club as a whole, should be reported in writing to the Ice Flyers organization. Complaints of conduct that might be viewed as detrimental to the welfare, interests or character of the Club or the Ice Flyers will be investigated, followed by: written warning to the member; suspension of membership; and/or dismissal from the Club and termination of membership without refund of current dues.
